Council Business

1. Election of new School Site Council Members, Cecile Cody and Jeanne Silvers for a term of three years beginning the 2007-2008 school year and concluding September, 2010. m/s/c Harper/Lane

2. Accept with regret resignation of Steve Quaid from the school site council effective immediately.
3. Review Healthy Kids Report. Denise Squires, TCOE, and Scott Lane, TUPE Coordinator for WES reported on the recent California Healthy Kids Survey (CHKS) given to WES 7th and 8th graders in the Spring of 2007. Members were given the report. All four goals of the Tobacco Use Prevention Education (TUPE) grant were reviewed and showed improvement. Medicinal marijuana use in the county was discussed at length and its impact on alcohol and drug use among our youth. Members were asked to choose a goal and review the strategies listed in the Trinity County Strategic Plan to become

- more familiar with the planned activities/action. Members feel goal 2-Feeling safe at school and goal 3-Feeling connected to school are priorities for WES. Would like to see teachers trained in Second Step and look at reinstating the WINGS program.
4. Program Specialist Report-Kathleen Graham
 - A. The California English Language Development Test (CELDT) has been given to all students that are required to complete the test. Some students will be exiting the program depending on their test results.
 - B. Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR). We are in the process of pre ID'ing students, the writing test will be in March and the main test will be in at the end of April.
 - C. We are currently in the process of reviewing math curriculum to consider for adoption.
 - D. Response to Intervention (RTI). The district recently identified our first student that qualifies for an Individual Education Plan (IEP) based on the District RTI criteria for qualifying.
 - E. After School Education and Safety Program (ASES) currently has an enrollment of 70.
 5. Principal's Report- Mrs. Morris highlighted the major goals of the Single Plan for Student Achievement for Weaverville Elementary. An update was given on the reading lab, junior high scheduling and professional development.
 6. It was reported by Mrs. Morris that Weaverville Elementary School was nominated as a Blue Ribbon School in California. WES was one of 35 schools in California nominated for the award. We won't know if we are a recipient until next school year.
 7. It was also reported by Mrs. Morris that WES is in the process of filling out the application for the California Distinguished School Program.
